

**AMENDMENT TO THE CONSTITUTION OF THE FEDERATION IN THE EXISTING CLAUSE 16 (OFFICE BEARERS) UNDER THE RULES AND REGULATIONS:**

**16. OFFICE BEARERS:**

16.1	a) President	-	1
	b) Vice President	-	7
	c) General Secretary	-	1
	d) Joint Secretary	-	2

- 16.2 The President is authorized to nominate One Associate Vice President and One Associate Joint Secretary in the Managing Committee without any voting rights and their office will be co-terminus with the other Office Bearers.

The Office Bearers will hold office for four years from the date of election. Office bearers who have completed one term and who are desirous of further terms shall deemed to be elected if he receives a single majority of the members present and voting in the election.

The President can hold the office for maximum period of twelve years (Three terms) with or without a break.

The General Secretary and the Treasurer can hold the Office for a maximum period of eight years (Two Terms) after which a minimum cooling off period of four years will apply to seek fresh election to either post.

The President, the General Secretary and the Treasurer shall cease to hold that post on attaining the age of 70 years.

No Government Servants should be allowed to hold elective office for a term o more than 4 years or for one term, whichever is less.

Previous sanction of the Government is required for a Government Servant to be an Office Bearer of the Federation.
