- 1) **2017 POKHARA ASTC 5TH SOUTH ASIAN TRIATHLON CHAMPIONSHIPS, FEWA LAKE, POKHRA, NEPAL (29TH APRIL 2017):** Indian Triathletes Pallavi Ashokbhai Retiwala & Gurudatt Devidas won the women's and men's category gold medal in the Pokhara 2017 ASTC 5th South Asian Triathlon Championships held on 29th April 2017 at Fewa Lake in Pokhara, Nepal. Gurudatt Devidas clocked 54 minutes and 51 seconds to finish ahead of Dilip Kumar also from India who completed the event in 55:59 minutes. Pallavi Ashokbhai Retiwala clocked the event in 1:01:03 hour.
- 2) **ITU LEVEL 1 COACHING COURSE HELD FROM 30TH APRIL TO 4TH MAY 2017 IN DUBAI:** Ms. Pooja Naresh Charushi, an Indian triathlete nominated by the Federation attended the ITU level 1 coaching course which held from 30th April to 4th May 2017 in Dubai.
